



DOMAINE DES TROIS FILLES

Region: Provence (Bandol) Village: La Cadière-d'Azur

Winemaker: Audrey Arlon

Property: 9 Hectares

Clinging to the hillside and overlooking the Mediterranean, the Arlon family's vineyard is surrounded by a haven of garrigue scrubland and centuries-old olive trees. It benefits from a micro-climate that imbues their wines with personality. In 2013, the Domaine des Trois Filles was established and they vinified their first harvest.

BANDOL ROUGE

75% Mourvèdre, 20% Grenache, 5% Cinsault

The vines are planted on hillside vineyards with Clay and limestone soils.

The fruit is manually harvested, followed by a fermentation and maceration in stainless steel vats.

The wine is then aged in traditional Bandol foudres(15-40 hl) for 18 months before bottling.

Prior to the establishment of Domaine de Trois Filles, Audrey learned how to tend to the vines and make wine at Domaine Tempier and Gros Noré in Bandol. Not a bad resumé if you wish to craft top quality wine in this historic appellation.
