



# DOMAINE DES TROIS FILLES

Region: Provence (Bandol) Village: La Cadière-d'Azur

Winemaker: Audrey Arlon

Property: 9 Hectares

Clinging to the hillside and overlooking the Mediterranean, the Arlon family's vineyard is surrounded by a haven of garrigue scrubland and centuries-old olive trees. It benefits from a micro-climate that imbues their wines with personality. In 2013, the Domaine des Trois Filles was established and they vinified their first harvest.

## *BANDOL ROSÉ*

60% Mourvèdre, 25% Grenache, 15% Cinsault

The vines are planted on hillside vineyards with Clay and limestone soils.

The fruit is manually harvested. Crushed and left for a brief skin maceration before being drawn off for fermentation.

The wine is then aged in concrete vats and steel tank for 4 to 5 months.

Prior to the establishment of Domaine de Trois Filles, Audrey learned how to tend to the vines and make wine at Domaine Tempier and Gros Noré in Bandol. Not a bad resumé if you wish to craft top quality wine in this historic appellation.
