



DOMAINE BOISSON

Region: Southern Rhône (Vaucluse) Village: Cairanne

Winemaker: Bruno Boisson

Property:

The Domaine dates back to the mid-19th century, when great-great grandfather of Régis, bought the land including a small stone cottage. Originated as a poly-culture farm. After WWII René Boisson, father of Régis developed the estate. After the olive trees froze in the winter of 1956, he decided to replace them with the vines. The current generation is Bruno Boisson, taking over outright for Régis in 2010.

It was in 1956 that René established his own production and left the Cave Cooperative of Cairanne. Boisson's first domaine bottling was in 1986. Vinification in the cellar is supervised by Philippe Cambie.

CÔTES DU RHÔNE VILLAGES CAIRANNE ROUGE

50% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 20% Mourvedre, 10% Carignan

The vines are planted to chalk and clay soils.

The grapes are vinified in concrete tank for up to three weeks. The wine is then aged in 90% concrete and 10% two and three year old barriques for 12-16 months before bottling.
